



Oklahoma Project Woman is a statewide comprehensive program dedicated to providing access to free breast health care that will facilitate the early diagnosis of breast cancer and decreasing the mortality rate for Oklahomans with no health insurance and limited financial resources.

We provide mammograms, diagnostic procedures, and surgical services.

Our program began serving uninsured low-income women in 1998 with five Tulsa hospitals as medical partners. As the program grew, more hospitals and communities were added.

By 2011, the organization was serving the entire state.

Clinics are the access points into the Oklahoma Project Woman (OPW) program and ultimately become the medical home for the patient. Medical partners are reimbursed a contracted rate for each procedure done. OPW's average cost is \$230 per patient. The medical partner agrees to write off the remainder of the procedure cost, so the patient owes nothing.

We have provided more than 63,000 vouchers for free breast health care for uninsured Oklahomans all made possible by our gracious donors and sponsors.

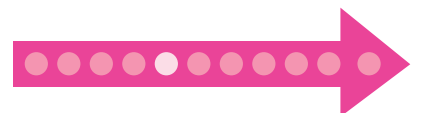
